

Checker Board Classic

Rules and Classes

All goats must have a scrapie tag or registered tattoo

All goats must have a health paper no older than 30 days

All Boer breeding animals will have to have registration papers in hand at check in to be in the registered Boer classes - otherwise will be in the commercial class

All wethers and commercial does will be weighed in at check-in and top two must weigh back within 5 lb +or –

Classes with less than two goats will be combined

Bucks will be allowed in the Boer, Myotonic , and Kiko classes

Wethers, Commercial Does, and other breed does not registered will be broke down by weight

Dairy Influence class rules: The wether must still have the dairy characteristic markings like the stripes on the face, blue ears, marbled hair, and lighter bone mass - otherwise they will be put in the wether class with the market wethers. Any combination of these characteristics will qualify you for the Dairy class. This classification will be at Steve and/or the judge's discretion.

Breeding Class Boers will follow the ABGA class standard 0-3 3-6 6-9 9-12 and so on

Order of show will be: % Class followed by full blood does and then full blood bucks

Ages will be set as of July 2, 2016
