- Be between the grades 7th and 12th
- Write an essay stating, “Why you should be chosen as the ambassador.” Must include what you plan to do or are currently doing to promote goats. (Essay needs to be between 100 and 1000 words.)
- Be active in raising or showing goats.
- Be available to interview with a panel of judges Friday, September 7th @ 7:00 P.M. at the Warren County Fairgrounds, Indianola, IA (Please wear casual business attire)
- Be available for recognition Saturday, September 9, 2018 at 8:00 A.M. at the Warren County Fairgrounds, Indianola, IA
- Be available for the following activities/events throughout the year
 - Be available to hand out ribbons at all IMGA sponsored shows
 - Be available to hand out awards at the 2019 Iowa State Fair Goat Show
 - Be available to mentor future ambassadors if the need arises.
 - Be able to write an article for the IMGA newsletter
 - Give a short presentation at the Annual IMGA Banquet
 - Be available for other activities (which may include the following, but are not limited too)
 - Assisting at clinics, IMGA banquet, ISU Ag Day, sales, and JIMGA events
