Additional Guidelines for any Non-Fair Livestock Show presented by the Clay County Fairgrounds. **Rules will be strongly enforced. Exhibitors will get one warning from the show committee if you do not comply you will be asked to leave.**

- Since social distancing is difficult in the show ring, classes must be limited to 10 or less exhibitors and all exhibitors and ring personnel must wear masks. **(Our Committee has a plan in place to make this possible to also be following ABGA rules. Face coverings cloth or paper must be worn in the ring this is per the facility.)**

- Stalling out of trailers is preferred to limit interaction between exhibitors. **Generators are encouraged if stalling out of the trailers.**
- If stalling inside a Fair & Events Center facility is necessary, an empty stall or pen must be located on all sides of an exhibitor's (or family's) pens. Aisles must be one-way. **(Signs will be posted in alleyways and penning will be monitored please check with the show committee before unloading.**
- **Tailgating, group meals, congregating in parking lots, stalling areas, wash racks, or show rings will be not allowed. There will be no bleachers available at any show ring.**
- Any independent concession trailers operating during the show will be expected to follow all appropriate food safety guidelines created by SafeServe.
- Hand sanitizer will be available and a limited supply of paper masks will be available. We hope to have a fun filled show like in the past but please be patient with us and all exhibitors. **Please remember to keep groups to less than 10 people. We are encouraging exhibitors to only bring the necessary people to the show, example: Parent and showman or Showman and one behind the scenes person to keep numbers at a minimum.**
- Be sure to look at the ABGA website for updated rule changes.
- Camping is available at the fair grounds in self contained campers.
- FYI: For the **pairs classes** on the entry forms please put down how many pairs of each and we will have classing breakdowns at check-in.

## SHOW RULES

All goats, market wethers, commercial breeding does, registered percentage and full blood Boer Goats, must be individually identified (see specific identification requirements below) on a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection and originate from herds or areas not under quarantine. The Certificate of Veterinary Inspection for goats will require clinical inspection by an accredited veterinarian within 30 days prior to date of entry to exhibition grounds.

**Identification Requirements for All Sexually Intact Goats.** All sexually intact goats, commercial breeding does, registered percentage and full blood Boer Goats, must be identified with an Individual Scrapie Flock of Origin identification tag or by a readable, official tattoo registered with the USDA. The complete ear tag number and/or complete tattoo must be listed on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection. To register your herd tattoo prefix, call 1-866-USDA-TAG. If tattoos are used instead of scrapie tags, complete numbers and/or letters from both ears must be listed on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection. The Certificate of Veterinary Inspection must also include a statement certifying the herd's participation in the Scrapie Program and include the scrapie premise ID number and/or the official herd tattoo prefix registered to the herd.

**Identification Requirements for Wethers.** All wethers must be identified with either an Individual Scrapie Flock of Origin identification tag, a registry tattoo or by an official alphanumeric metal clip applied by a veterinarian. This Scrapie Tag number or registry tattoo (both right and left ear numbers and letters) must be listed on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection. The ear tags must match the identification number on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection. The Certificate of Veterinary Inspection must also include a statement certifying the herd's participation in the Scrapie Program and include the scrapie premise number.

Any animal with any contagious diseases including, but not limited to, pink eye, sore mouth, ringworm, or abscess in any stage will not be admitted. In the case of a dispute, a veterinarian will be called at the owner's expense. Animals refused for health reasons are required to stay in their vehicle and will not be shown. Please be considerate of the animals of other exhibitors by not bringing those goats that may be refused entry for health reasons.

The American Boer Goat Association, or the Little Sioux Showdown will not be held responsible for illness, injury, damage or loss of animals, person or property.

**NO REFUNDS WILL BE MADE.**

**ARRIVAL TIME.** Goats entered in Saturday shows may begin arriving at 1pm, Friday, June 26, 2019. Penning will be supervised by the show committee. Show superintendents will have final say on pens. Pen space will NOT be available for goats that do not have a show entry association (self-entry or progeny entry).

**\*\*NO EXCEPTIONS\*\***

**STALL BEDDING.** You are required to use shavings for bedding. Plan to bring your own. Carpeting, rubber mats and straw are not allowed as bedding. You may want to bring snow fencing to put around your pen to keep your young goats in their pen.

**SHOW SANCTIONING.** The Open Boer Goat Shows will be sanctioned by the ABGA. Awards will be presented based on the corresponding association sanction rules. Any animal not checked in with an ABGA registration certificate will not receive recognition in any ABGA publications or website. Such animals are not eligible for ennoblement points.

**ENOBLED HERD BOOK POINTS.** Goats entered under their ABGA registration numbers and presenting their Certificates of Registration will be eligible to earn points for their actual placing in the show as described "Criteria for Ennoblement of a Boer Goat."

**GOAT OWNERSHIP.** Exhibitor is required to refrain from showing any animal owned by the presiding show judge 90 days prior to show date.

**NUMBER OF ENTRIES SHOWN BY EXHIBITOR PER CLASS.** Each exhibitor may show no more than three (3) animals in each class.

**SUBSTITUTIONS.** Substitutions are allowed in the same class only and must have same ownership as the original entry. Substitutions will be made at check-in or can be emailed prior to check in to the show secretary.

**ENTRIES AND ELIGIBILITY OF ANIMALS.** Market does/wethers and commercial breeding does do not need to be registered. All Boer percentage and full blood Boer Goats must be registered in the ABGA Herdbook before the show. Temporary or original ABGA registration certificates are required to be presented at show check-in. A stamped duplicate or faxed duplicate application showing the date received by the association is acceptable for animals under three (3) months of age. Animals must be registered in the name of the exhibitor. Exhibitor is defined as the owner of the animal

on its registry certificate. Proof of birth date will be the date on the registration certificate.

**TATTOOS.** All animals must be tattooed with a legible tattoo or other means of permanent identification consistent with its registration. If an animal is disqualified due to illegible or inconsistent tattoos, all lower placing animals will be moved up in placement. Tattoos or other means of permanent identification of winning animals will be checked in the ring and recorded. The permanent identification must match the registration paper. No tattooing allowed after unloading. If the animal has a microchip as its permanent identification, the exhibitor is responsible for providing a microchip reader.

**COMPUTING AGES.** Birth dates, as listed on the Certificate of Registration, will be used to determine the class divisions. The Saturday show date will be the base date in computing all ages for the entire weekend. Take the show date and count back to the birth date of the goat to determine the age and the class of the animal. For example, for a December 1 show, an animal with a January 1 birth date would be eleven (11) months old and would show in a kid class.

**DISQUALIFICATION.** Any goat showing any pronounced defect or abnormality, such as a weak constitution, unthrifty condition, overshot jaw or undershot jaw, abnormal or draining abscesses, will be barred from showing in any of the classes. Illegible tattoos or tattoos inconsistent with registration will result in disqualification. Any doe over 24 months of age that has not kidded and cannot prove a current pregnancy will not be allowed to show. No artificial coloring will be allowed.

**FITTING.** Fitting will be left up to the discretion of the exhibitor.

All market does/wethers must be uniformly clipped with 3/8" length of hair or less above the knee and hock joints, to include the head, excluding the tail prior to arrival on the grounds.

**CLASSES.** Market does/wethers and commercial breeding does do not need to be registered. All Boer percentage and full blood Boer Goats must be registered in the ABGA Herdbook. Percentage doe classes are for goats 50% to 88%. Purebred/Full Blood classes are for does that are 15/16 (93.75%) and higher and bucks that are 31/32 (96.87%) and higher. Bucks 96.86% and lower are not eligible to be shown. Progeny of fresh does will only be allowed in the ring for Mother/Daughter pair class. The Division Champions will be selected from the first place winners of the individual classes. The Division Reserve Champions will be selected from the remaining first place class winners of the individual classes plus the second place winner of the class from which the Division Champion was chosen. The Grand

Champion will be selected from the Division Champions. The Reserve Grand Champion will be selected from the remaining Division Champions plus the Reserve Division Champion from which the Grand Champion was chosen.

JUDGING. At the discretion of the judge and Show Officials, goats may be turned loose in the ring as a function of judging.

RIBBONS AND ROSETTES. Ribbons will be awarded. Division Champions, Reserve Division Champions, Grand Champions and Reserve Grand Champions in the ABGA sanctioned show will receive rosettes.

BRACING OF ABGA PERCENTAGE, FULL BLOOD DOES AND BUCKS. Bracing will no longer be allowed by breeding stock entries at ABGA Sanctioned Shows. ABGA states goats' front legs must be on the ground during the Judge's evaluation. Exhibitors may lift the front feet off the ground for a period not to exceed 10 seconds when posing the goat.

DRIVING OR BRACING OF MARKET DOES/WETHERS. Bracing of animals will be tolerated if the animal has all four (4) feet on the ground. Exhibitors must use a collar or halter to control their animal. Abusive treatment of animals is not permitted. Any violation will result in dismissal.

MUZZLING. Muzzling of animals is prohibited.

BUCKETS. Water buckets must be secured and in pens at all times. Fresh water must be in buckets in sufficient quantity for the number of goats in the pen. This will be enforced.

NONCOMPLIANCE. Noncompliance to show rules will result in dismissal from the show. Show officials have the right to ban an individual if they consider it necessary for the good of the show.

COMMERCIAL MEAT GOAT BREEDING DOE CLASSES. Commercial does will be judged on meat goat breeding characteristics and may not show in the percentage or full blood divisions. All commercial does will be aged and shown in accordance with teeth development: Doe Kids = milk teeth, Yearling Does = 2 teeth and Ages Does = 4+ teeth. Any doe over 24 months of age that has not kidded and cannot prove a current pregnancy will not be allowed to show.

MARKET DOE/WETHER CLASSES. There will be an Open market goat division. All market does/wethers will be weighed in at check in by Show Officials. Classes

will be determined by weight and announced and posted prior to the show. All market does/wethers must have their milk teeth. No adult teeth will be allowed.
